

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Boundary Commission, St. Louis County. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by Boundary Commission, St. Louis County for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Boundary Commission, St. Louis County public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: Boundary Commission, St. Louis County does not read any of your private online communications. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from Boundary Commission, St. Louis County so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County.

Use of your Personal Information

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County collects and uses your personal information to operate the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County Web site and deliver the services you have requested. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Boundary Commission, St. Louis County. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Boundary Commission, St. Louis County may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Boundary Commission, St. Louis County, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within Boundary Commission, St. Louis County, in order to determine what Boundary Commission, St. Louis County services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Boundary Commission, St. Louis County to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Boundary Commission, St. Louis County or the site; (b) protect and defend the

rights or property of Boundary Commission, St. Louis County; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Boundary Commission, St. Louis County, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Boundary Commission, St. Louis County Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Boundary Commission, St. Louis County pages, or register with Boundary Commission, St. Louis County site or services, a cookie helps Boundary Commission, St. Louis County to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Boundary Commission, St. Louis County Web site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County features that you customized. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Boundary Commission, St. Louis County services or Web sites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

Boundary Commission, St. Louis County secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Boundary Commission, St. Louis County secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. The Boundary Commission, St. Louis County does not accept payments via its website therefore it does not use SSL protocol.
