

MEETINGS

The Boundary Commission holds three different kinds of meetings: Regular Monthly Meetings, Committee Meetings and Public Hearings. Meetings are open to the public except when state law allows them to be closed.

1. The Regular Monthly Meeting is held on the fourth Tuesday of each month. Typically, the Commission meets at the **St. Louis County Government Building, 41 S. Central, 8th Floor Conference Room, Clayton, MO 63105**. The meetings begin promptly at **6:30 p.m.** and serve a number of purposes: general public comment, staff updates of ongoing office activities, committee reports and the Commission's actions regarding Map Plans and Proposals.
2. Committee Meetings are held on an as needed basis. The Commission has standing Personnel and Finance committees that have been created regarding Commission Rules and By-laws. These meetings usually take place at the Boundary Commission office at 168 N. Meramec, Ste. 140, St. Louis, MO 63105.
3. The Commission is required by the statute to hold Public Hearings regarding Map Plans and Proposals. These hearings are scheduled in a timely manner when specific submissions demand public input and presentations by the submitting and affected entities.
