- (3) Administration costs shall also be charged to the owner, his developer and/or agent(s), for any major development. Administration's cost shall include, but shall not be limited to, the current hourly rate for the Director of Public Works, City Engineer, Building

Commissioner, City Attorney, Building Inspectors, Secretaries, Clerk Typists, Draftsperson, Copy Equipment Operators or any other city employee(s) and shall also include the current duplicating charge(s) as set by ordinance. Major developments shall include Subdivision projects, Special Permit projects and all non-residential rezoning projects.

Prior to reviewing building plans and issuing building permits for any major development, the Director of Public Works or his designee shall estimate the administration costs and shall require the owner, his developer and/or agent(s), to deposit with the City this estimated amount for their particular All administration costs project. associated with a particular project (including preliminary and all consultations subsequent prior Planning and Zoning and City Council approvals) will be charged against the funds on deposit on a monthly basis. During the course of a particular project, if funds are not adequate to cover administration costs then the owner (his developer and/or agents) will be required to deposit an additional estimated amount with the City.
