ORDINANCE NO. 00- 1196

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN ANNEXATION MAP PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 72.423, RSMO, AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF SAID MAP WITH THE BOUNDARY COMMISSION OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2000.

WHEREAS, Sections 72.400 through 72.430, RSMO 1994, as amended, prescribes the rules, regulations and procedures governing annexations within St. Louis County, and,

WHEREAS, Section 72.423, RSMO 1994, as amended, provides that all boundary changes shall be subject to a five (5) year planning cycle and that cities must file with the St. Louis County Boundary Commission a five (5) year map plan prior to July 1, 2000 which will govern potential annexations which might occur between April 1, 2001 and April 1, 2006, and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bills 82 and 162, enacted by the General Assembly effective June 14, 1999, established a moratorium on annexations within St. Louis County until April 1, 2001 so as to allow time for reconstitution of the St. Louis County Boundary and for submittal and review of annexation map plans, and,

WHEREAS, failure to submit an annexation map plan, or to include any specific area within said plan, will preclude the City from pursuing any annexation proposals during the five (5) year period which will end April 1, 2006 (inclusion of an area within a map plan does not require the City to actively pursue its annexation during that same period).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: The Board of Aldermen of the City of Manchester does hereby adopt the Master Annexation Map Plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference thereto.

Section Two: The City Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take all administrative and legal steps necessary to file said map and related information with the Boundary Commission of St. Louis County prior to July 1, 2000, all as provided in Section 72.423, RSMO 1994.

Section Three: The City Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to initiate a comprehensive review of all areas depicted on said annexation map plan and to prepare for consideration by the Board of Aldermen a cost-benefit analysis of annexation of each area and a preliminary plan of intent, all in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Boundary Commission.

Section Four: Adoption of said Master Annexation Map does not commit the City to annexation of any or all of the areas depicted on said map plan, but simply preserves the right to file annexation petitions on any or all of these areas within the five (5) year period ending April 1, 2006.

Section Five: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
