


Services provided to Chesterfield Residents

Map Plan Submittal






- Proposal to annex Clarkson Valley area and three unincorporated St. Louis County area
- The submitted Map Plan proposal serves to reserve the City of Chesterfield's right to pursue annexation during the proposal phase, should Clarkson Valley express interest in merging with the City of Chesterfield
- City did not have any specific criteria for including these areas.
- Currently, there is <u>no phasing considered</u> or timetable for making the proposal to the Commission.

(Unincorporated St. Louis Area, total of 3.69 acres)






1. Vacant Land north of Saddle Creek Road

Map Plan Submittal (City of Clarkson Valley)





- The Map Plan includes three zip codes of Clarkson Valley area. Total area of 2.75 square miles.
- Majority of City of Clarkson Valley are residential areas. Including those areas in the City of Chesterfield boundary is neither an advantage or disadvantage for the City of Chesterfield.
- Currently, City of Chesterfield provides police service to the City of Clarkson Valley.
- If the City of Clarkson Valley expresses interest in consolidating with the City of Chesterfield, then Chesterfield will provide the annexed area with the same facilities it currently offers to its residents.
