- Approximately 5.09 square miles

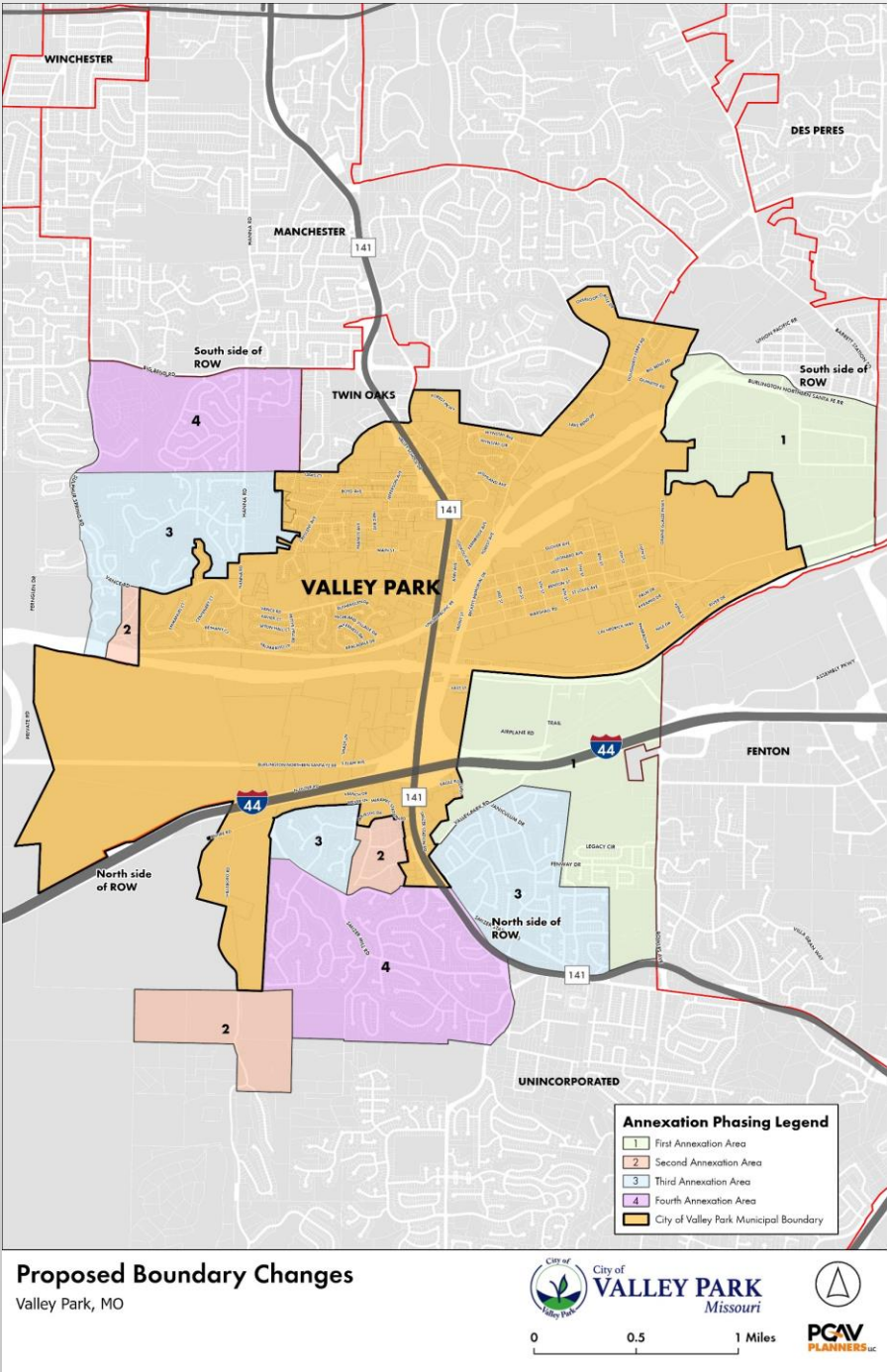
